This 65% by weight is the minimum amount of sucrose which will preserve neutral syrup. If one wants to formulate a syrup containing less sucrose, the quantity of alcohol, or other preservatives, may be estimated by considering the USP Syrup equivalent and the free water equivalent. One may assume that free water is preserved by 18% alcohol.

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
